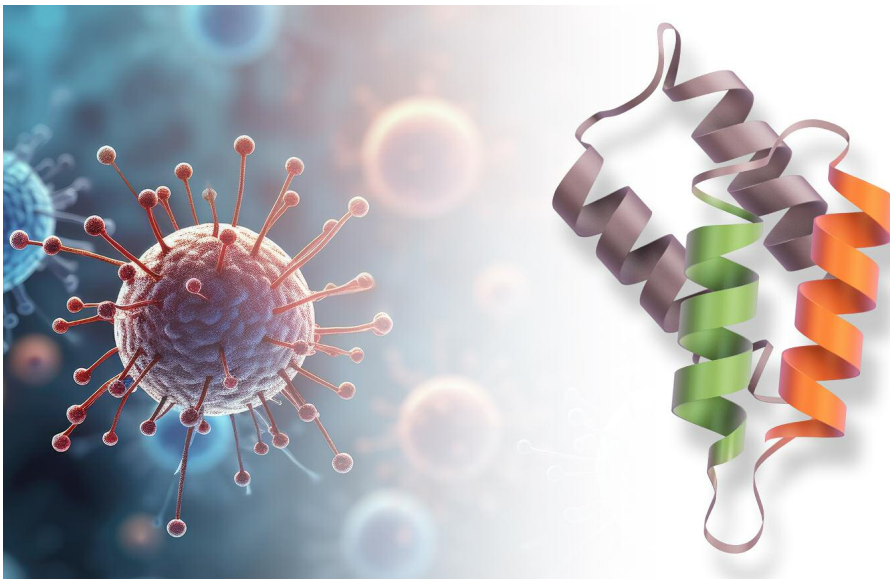

pandemic level, all depends on who writes what. When Coronavirus (Covid) was in full swing all of a sudden we were testing deer and the statements were made that we (humans) were giving it to deer and the deer were giving it to us. Who is doing what to the other? Very confusing. Who carries what?

Deer and many animals have been carriers of the Coronavirus since the mid-1960s, probably earlier but that was first testing. I heard nothing about it then and that it could become a pandemic. Evolutionary changes in Covid in deer populations have not resulted in a virus that can evade our antibodies.
