PRION DISEASE SINCE 1947

The deer population in the United States is strong, with an estimated total of around 35 to 36 million deer across all species. The majority of the deer population consists of white-tailed deer, whose numbers have recovered to roughly pre-colonization levels due to conservation efforts. Populations vary by state, with Texas having the largest population of over 5 million white-tailed deer. In some areas, particularly in the East and Midwest, high densities lead to concerns about disease transmission and deer vehicle collisions. The number one cause of death for adult white-tail deer across North America is hunter harvest, followed by vehicle collisions, while for fawns, predation is the leading killer. The deadliest deer disease of viral origin is all strains of Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease (EHD).

The Prion Disease which causes Scrapie's, CWD, MCD and JK was first documented as discovered in 1947. CWD was first discovered and documented in 1967. CWD was discovered in mule deer in 2002 in the southern areas of New Mexico. Mule deer migrate between Texas and New Mexico. CWD was discovered in mule deer in 2012 in West Texas. In 1998 a major surveillance effort started in the U.S. to map CWD in farmed and wild cervids (deer family). In 2002 a national CWD plan was created. Basically, it took 50 years to decide if this was really an epidemic or could this be used as a tool for a far bigger picture. Science does not indicate an epidemic, but politics and ulterior motives are thriving in regard to CWD. Lets not forget that the prion disease was originally discovered in 1732, almost 300 years ago and for 200 years we didn't seem to be concerned, So why now!! The deer population is thriving and healthy today and has been for the last 30 years. The deer don't seem to be bothered by CWD, as for them life goes on under their normal cycle. The planet is not being overtaken by Zombie Deer,
